Data Protection and Cookie Policy at Leicester MusicFest

Data Protection Statement

Leicester Musicfest records, safeguards and uses information that we hold on users when they take part in any of our events. MusicFest is committed to the protection of your privacy through compliance with the Data Protection Act and current best practice.

Legal basis for processing your information

When you sign up to be in a competition or take part in a workshop or masterclass, the information we take from you and subsequently process will be done on the basis of MusicFest's legitimate interest in processing that data because of the relationship established (General Data Protection Regulation Art. 6(1)(f)). We may ask your consent to process any sensitive information, such as medical conditions, and process this information on the basis of that consent (General Data Protection Regulation Art. 6(1)(a)). Remember, you can email us on info@leicestermusicfest.com to change your information or request for removal of certain information from our systems or to ask questions about the way in which we process your information.

How we collect information

In order to take part in any Leicester MusicFest activity, we request that you provide us with basic information that will help us identify you and allow us to help you get the best experience from Leicester MusicFest. We collect this information either:

Via the web, when you signup and/or pay for an event online By phone when you signup and/or pay for an event In person from you, when you attend an event at Leicester MusicFest.

The information we collect

We need to be able to identify our participants and staff at the festival. This requires basic information such as your full name, address and contact details. It might also include more sensitive data such as any medical issues that might affect your requirements, or your bank details for processing payments.

How we use the information

We use your personal information to sign you up to a Leicester MusicFest event; To ensure we meet our safeguarding obligations whilst you are attending MusicFest. We also use photography and film to record and promote Leicester MusicFest - participants are asked for consent for this when signing up. You can email us on info@leicestermusicfest.com to change your information or request for removal from our systems. If you place first, second, or third in our competition, we will retain your personal information for a period of 18 months from the date of the competition. After this period, we will delete all personal information except for your first name and surname, which will be stored in our archives solely for the purpose of maintaining a historical record of competition winners. This information will be retained indefinitely for archival purposes.

We store the first four characters of your postcode, anonymously, long term to demonstrate our reach in funding applications.

We never share any of your personal data with third parties If you consent to our marketing, you may be added to a subscribers list to receive updates about Leicester MusicFest.

All non-anonymous data pertaining to an event you have signed up for will be deleted from our databases 6 months after the event.

By participating in the competitions, workshops or masterclasses, you consent to the collection, retention, and processing of your personal information as outlined in this policy.

Data Processing and Retention Policy for Dashboard Accounts

When you create a dashboard account with us, your name and email address will be processed by our authentication provider, *Clerk*. For more details on how Clerk handles your personal information, please refer to their privacy policy available <u>here</u>.

By maintaining a dashboard account with us, you agree to the storage of your personal information (including your name and email address) on our database. This information will be retained for the duration of your account's existence. Should you choose to delete your dashboard account at any point in the future, all non-anonymous data associated with your account will be permanently removed from our database.

Social Media Platforms

We frequently use social media platforms to promote Leicester MusicFest. We use photographs of our events only with permission.

We also have a Leicester MusicFest professional photographer to come and take photos; permission will be asked for before any photoshoots.

Sometimes staff members may ask to take a photo during or after the event. No photographs or videos are taken without informing those present first. Any photographs used on our sites can be removed if the person wishes. We have a Facebook, Instagram and Twitter Leicester MusicFest account which provides information about our activities.

Cookie Policy –

Data collected by Wix whilst using www.leicestermusicfest.com

1. What is a Cookie?

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers downloaded on to your computer when you access certain websites. In general, cookies allow a website to recognise a user's computer.

The most important thing to know about cookies placed by Wix is that they make our website a bit more user-friendly, for example, by remembering site preferences and language settings.

2. Why does Wix use Cookies?

We use these cookies and other similar technologies for a number of purposes, including:

Duration:

Depending on their function, Cookies may have different durations. There are session cookies and persistent cookies:

Session cookies only last for your online session. It means that the browser deletes these cookies once you close your browser

Persistent cookies stay on your device after the browser has been closed and last for the period of time specified in the cookie

Categories:

The cookies used on our website fall into one of four categories:

Essential Cookies let you move around the website and use essential features like secure and private areas.

Analytic Cookies let us understand how you use our website (e.g. which pages you visit), to provide statistics on how our website is used, improve the website by identifying any errors, and performance issues.

Functional cookies are cookies used to remember choices users make to improve their experience (e.g. language).

Marketing cookies are used to collect information about the impact of our marketing campaigns performed in other websites on users and non-users.
